at Financial Centre Parkway Offering Primary Care for All Ages**

LITTLE ROCK — UAMS Health Neighborhood Clinic opened an additional location today, offering primary care for people of all ages from University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) providers.

The clinic is at 11300 Financial Centre Parkway in West Little Rock in the space formerly occupied by a UAMS obstetrics and gynecology clinic, which has moved to the UAMS Health Women’s Center at 6119 Midtown Ave.

Primary care physicians and health care providers serve as a first point of contact for a wide variety of medical needs, from management of chronic conditions like diabetes and heart disease to treatment of common concerns like respiratory and gastrointestinal illness.

UAMS primary care providers create a medical home for patients of all ages, where all health needs can be addressed. As an extra advantage, if the primary care provider determines the patient needs to see a specialist, the patient will already be in the UAMS network of providers.
