Patel sees patients at the UAMS Health <u>Kidney Transplant Clinic</u> and <u>Liver Tran</u> <u>Clinic</u> in the Outpatient Center on the main UAMS campus in Little Rock.

Patel is also an assistant professor in the UAMS College of Medicine's Departme Surgery. UAMS Health is the only center in Arkansas that offers adult liver and b transplants.

Patel obtained a bachelor's degree in biochemistry from Baylor University and a degree from the Louisiana State University-Shreveport School of Medicine. He completed his residency in general surgery at the University of Arizona College of Medicine and a fellowship in abdominal transplants at the Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine in Chicago.
