Clinic hours are 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Wednesday and Friday. On Thursday, the clinic is open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Cross will also see patients in El Dorado in the future.

"I am proud of what I have accomplished over the years but know it is time to transition to something else," Cross said. "I am excited to continue taking care of my patients, be a mentor to students and resident doctors and hopefully pass on some of the knowledge I have been blessed to learn."
