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**UAMS Brain Injury Program to Offer
Free Virtual Workshop Aug. 20**

LITTLE ROCK — The [UAMS Brain Injury Program](#) will host a virtual workshop on Aug. 20 to connect anyone affected by a traumatic brain injury (TBI) to helpful resources and support.

Workshop attendees will learn about free Arkansas resources, digital health clinics, a free 24/7 Brain and Spine call center, brain injury support groups and more. In addition to interactive discussions, the event will feature Two Sides to Every Story with Capt. Steven Chamness of the North Little Rock Police Department.

The UAMS Brain Injury Program has partnered with several entities throughout the state to provide educational and professional resources for people living with a brain injury, including information for their family members, caregivers and health care providers.

UAMS is the state's only health sciences university, with colleges of Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Health Professions and Public Health; a graduate school; a hospital; a main campus in Little Rock; a Northwest Arkansas regional campus in Fayetteville; a statewide network of regional campuses; and seven institutes: the Winthrop P. Rockefeller Cancer Institute, Jackson T. Stephens Spine & Neurosciences Institute, Harvey & Bernice Jones Eye Institute, Psychiatric Research Institute, Donald W. UAMS includes UAMS Health, a statewide health system that encompasses all of UAMS' clinical enterprise. UAMS is the only adult Level 1 trauma center in the state. UAMS has 3,553 students and 1,030 medical residents and fellows, and two dental residents. It is the state's largest public employer with about 12,000 employees, including 1,200 physicians who provide care to patients at UAMS, its regional campuses, Arkansas Children's, the VA Medical Center and Baptist Health.
